### Class Objectives,

## After completing this course, students should be able to

- 1. Hold lengthy conversations using only English.
- 2. Be able and willing to ask questions in English for clarification and further information.
- 3. Feel comfortable when speaking English before a small audience.
- 4. Express information, opinions, and ideas, about various topics with adequate support and be able to answer follow-up questions.

# The Practice and Feature of Class (Changes for Spring semester)

- 1. The textbook, *Talking for Real*, *Book 2*, will be used for some classes. Prepare for these classes by completing the survey part in each and by previewing each exercise
